Northfield BID High Street Security Officers

For our BID2 campaign message in 2016, we said that we would pilot a high street security officer, with a SIA Door Supervisor badge, to provide foot patrols throughout Northfield high street. We envisaged this officer would provide a 'reassuring figure' for you, your staff, and your customers – providing a 'safe and secure' Northfield Town Centre to deter incidences of business crime, shop theft and supporting business owners and other security guards from the 'unsavoury elements' that visit Northfield, who disrupt your business and your trade.

Roll on to Autumn 2021, and four high street security officers later. The BID has now employed the two of best High Street Security Officers we have ever had! Both Tom and Ben are thoroughly enthusiastic about the roles that they have undertaken on behalf of Northfield BID and the Northfield business community.

They are:

- Proactively visiting businesses to check their 'health and well-being'.
- Supporting other security guards in the apprehension of those that want to cause anti-social behaviour in Northfield
- Actively talking to our partners within Northfield Shopping Centre and West Midlands Police in order to share intelligence.
- Carrying out foot patrols, determined by business need.
- One of the instigators in forming an informal Retail Crime Partnership with national retailer security officers, business owners and the neighbourhood policing teams.

Both Tom and Ben have proved themselves to be a true professionals, collaborating with partners by providing solutions to deter low level crime.

In October to November 2021, the Northfield business community will be asked once again to consider taking part in the renewal for Northfield BID for a third term.



Once again, you will be asked to vote upon the priorities and services that the BID hope to provide for a third term. The service that Tom and Ben provides will be under the priority of 'Protecting Northfield'.

We hope that if you would like the service that the BID High Street Security Officers provide for Northfield Town Centre to continue, you will be favourable in supporting the BID for a third term, so that we can continue to provide the excellent work that Northfield BID has carried out for the past nine years.

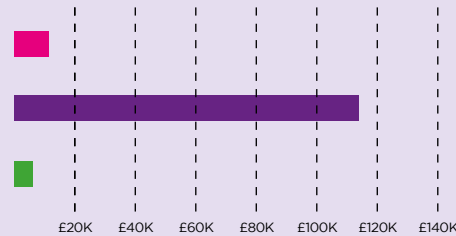


BID income & expenditure

Income

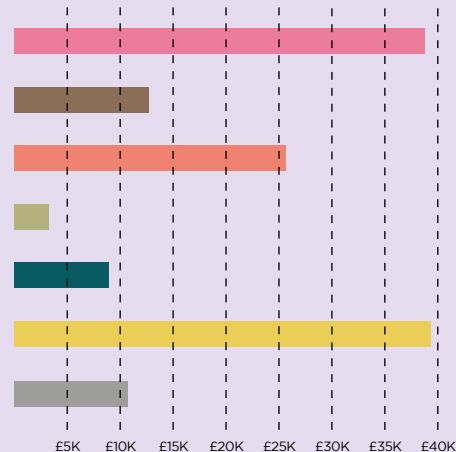
